# **Principles**

#### Mana atua empowerment

Enhance the mana of the child, and the child's sense of him or herself as a capable person and competent learner

#### Kotahitanga Holistic development

Focus on the whole child and reflect the holistic way in which children learn

#### Whanau tangata Family & community

Include families and whānau

#### Ng*a* hohonga Relationships

Recognise the people, places and things that support children's learning

## Purpose



Enhancing learning and development by giving feedback

• Documenting learning and progress

Evaluating and improving:

- Interactions between teachers and children, and between children
- the physical environment
- pedagogies and practices
- Enhancing relationships with families and whānau
- Identifying children who need additional support

### Focus



Children's developing knowledge, skills, attitudes and dispositions as related to Te Whāriki's strands and learning outcomes.



**Positive learning** dispositions e.g courage, curiosity, trust, playfulness, perseverance, confidence and responsibility.



**Dispositional behaviours** for learning e.g. taking an interest, being involved, persisting, taking risks, asking for help, expressing a point of view or sharing knowledge.



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
